Please read all pages as it contains all information needed to apply and compete in the pageant. Applications may be typed or handwritten. Please make sure all handwritten applications are legible. For contestants ages 0 to 17 applications must be signed by a parent or guardian. Contestants ages 18 and older may sign their own applications. There is a requirement of a **\$35.00** entry fee. Entry fee must be paid no later than **September 9th, 2021**. The entry fee is **NOT** refundable.

The Miss Anderson County Burgoo Festival pageant is a preliminary for the Miss Kentucky Festivals state pageant. The entry fee of \$35.00 does **NOT** go toward **ANY** entry fee for Miss Kentucky Festival state pageant should the runners - up or division queens choose to attend.

Miss/Mister Burgoo Festival Pageant Guidelines

- Girls Must be ages 0-24, boys must be 0-7 day of the pageant, 9-24-22
- Must be an Anderson County resident
 - Must NOT be married
 - Must compete in **ALL** areas of competition to be eligible for the Miss Anderson County Burgoo Festival title.
 - If you are competing in the Prince or Princess division you cannot compete in Little Miss and Mister as well. You must pick one or the other.
 - All contestants no matter if they are competing individually or in pairs must fill out an application and pay the \$35.00 entry fee.

Prince (4-6 years) - Patriotic wear only

Girls:

Baby Miss (0-10 Months) - Patriotic wear only

Tiny Miss (11-23 Months) - Patriotic wear only

Mini Miss (2-3 years) - Patriotic wear only

Princess (4-6) - Patriotic wear only

Jr. Pre-Teen (7-9) - Patriotic wear and personal introduction only

Pre-Teen (10-12) - Patriotic wear and personal introduction only

Jr. Teen (13-15) - Patriotic wear, personal introduction, formal wear, and on-stage question.

Teen (16-19) - Patriotic wear, personal introduction, formal wear, and on-stage question.

Miss (20-24) - Patriotic wear, personal introduction, formal wear, and on-stage question.

Pairs:

Little Miss & Mister (5-7)- Patriotic wear only

Personal Introduction

The personal introduction competition will take place during the patriotic wear competition. You will give your personal introduction after walking in your patriotic wear. Your personal introduction should include your name, age, and your parents' names/where you go to school.

Formal Wear

The formal wear competition allows the contestants to dress up and practice poise and grace. For formal wear, consider a prom or homecoming dress. Wear something you would wear to a dance. This should be age appropriate. If you are doubting if it's age appropriate, it probably isn't.



Patriotic wear

In the patriotic wear competition, you will be modeling your patriotic wear or red, white, and blue themed outfit. Pick an outfit that is fun and shows your personality. If you choose to use a handheld prop like an American flag, please remember that you will be giving your personal introduction in that outfit. You should be able to give your personal introduction without your prop being a distraction. If you choose to use a prop, please make sure that it is handheld size and can be carried on stage by yourself. All patriotic wear should be age appropriate.

Onstage questions

The on-stage question will be during the formal wear competition. After you finish with your formal wear modeling you will head to the emcee and answer a question. The on-stage questions will not be questions with right or wrong answers. They will be questions about you. Below are some examples but this is not an exact list of what can/will be asked.

- What is your favorite color and why?
- What is your favorite food and why?
- What is your favorite class/subject in school and why?
- Where is your favorite restaurant and why?
- If you could go anywhere on vacation, where would you go and why?
- What qualities do you look for in a friend and why?
- If you were judging this pageant, what would be the most important quality you would look for in the winner?
- What is your favorite part of living in Anderson County and why?
- What do you think the best part of the Burgoo Festival is and why?
- Describe Kentucky to someone who has never visited our state.
