A DANGER



Machine must be properly grounded to prevent electrical shock to personnel. Failure to do so could result in serious injury, or death.

Always unplug the equipment before cleaning or servicing.

Motor & Master Switch: Turns motor (spinning head) on/off and supplies power to the Heat Switch.

Heat Switch: Turns the heating element on/off.


Heat Control: Adjusts power to the heating element.

Note: This has been pre-set for your convenience.



Locks/unlocks the Bell Housing (spinning head) for transport.

Prior to operation, rotate both Lock-N-Go handles to the vertical position.



ightarrow NEVER OPERATE WITH LOCK-N-GO HANDLES IN TRANSPORT (HORIZONTAL) POSITION \leftarrow

PREPARING AND POWERING ON THE MACHINE

- 1) The Heat Switch and the Motor & Master Switch should be in the OFF position.
- 2) With the spinner head NOT spinning, pour Flossugar into the center of the spinner head.
- ALWAYS fill to ~90% DO NOT OVERFILL! (If using Flossugar pouches, use the entire pouch.)
- NEVER ADD FLOSSUGAR when motor is running (ie when spinner head is spinning)!
- ONLY USE THE FLOSSUGAR SERVING KITS SUPPLIED BY THE COMPANY!
- 3) Turn the Motor & Master Switch ON. Wait 10 seconds, THEN turn the Heat Switch ON.
- 4) The Heat Control Knob has been pre-set and removed for your convenience.

DO NOT PUT HANDS OR OB. DO NOT FILL SPINNER HEAD

DO NOT PUT HANDS OR OBJECTS IN ROTATING SPINNER HEAD.

- DO NOT FILL SPINNER HEAD WITH SUGAR WHILE IT IS ROTATING.
- WEAR EYE PROTECTION.
- DO NOT PUT HANDS NEAR ROTATING SPINNER HEAD.
- USE FLOSS CONE TO COLLECT COTTON CANDY.


HOW TO MAKE COTTON CANDY

STEP 1) Pick a paper cone. If it won't come out, twist it off the stack. Grip the pointed end of the cone.

STEPS 2-3) Roll the cone in the web of cotton candy in the pan until cotton candy starts sticking to the cone.

STEP 4) With the cotton candy attached to the cone, lift the cone up from the pan and continuing rolling.

STEPS 5-8) Keep rolling the cone to wrap more cotton candy as you move around the top edge of the pan.



ONCE YOU HAVE A SUFFICIENTLY LARGE CONE OF COTTON CANDY, REMOVE THE COMPLETED COTTON CANDY CONE, AND PLACE IN THE STAINLESS STEEL COTTON CANDY STAND PROVIDED WITH YOUR RENTAL.

IMPORTANT: REPEAT STEPS 1-8 UNTIL MACHINE IS OUT OF FLOSSUGAR & STOPS PRODUCING COTTON CANDY

→ <u>NEVER TURN OFF MACHINE WHILE STILL PRODUCING COTTON CANDY (EXCEPT IN CASE OF EMERGENCY)</u>

REFILLING THE MACHINE

- 1) When the spinner head needs to be refilled with Flossugar, or to stop the machine, <u>turn the Heat Switch to OFF</u> and <u>ALLOW THE MOTOR TO RUN FOR AT LEAST 1 MINUTE TO "COOL DOWN" THE SPINNER HEAD</u>.
- 2) After waiting for at least one minute, turn the Motor & Master Switch to OFF.

\rightarrow IMPORTANT \leftarrow

FAILURE TO COOL DOWN SPINNER HEAD COULD RESULT IN LEAVING MELTED FLOSSUGAR IN SPINNER HEAD.

IF MOTOR IS RESTARTED, THIS MELTED FLOSSUGAR WILL EXIT THE FLOSS AND COULD CAUSE BURNS

3) Refill and start over per the instructions on the "PREPARING & POWERING ON THE MACHINE" page and the "HOW TO MAKE COTTON CANDY" page.

SHUTTING DOWN THE MACHINE

- 1) When completing operation for the day (or any prolonged period), first ensure the machine has stopped producing cotton candy and is completely empty of Flossugar.
- 2) THEN turn the Heat Switch OFF and allow the motor (spinner head) to run for 1-2 minutes to "cool down".
- 3) FINALLY turn the Motor & Master Switch OFF and allow the motor to come to a COMPLETE stop. Unplug the power supply and ensure no untrained persons or minors are allowed near the machine.
 - ightarrow IMPORTANT: NEVER ATTEMPT TO CLEAN THE COTTON CANDY MACHINE YOURSELF \leftarrow
 - ightarrow IMPORTANT: NEVER PUT WATER IN THE SPINNER HEAD OR ANYWHERE NEAR THE MACHINE \leftarrow
 - → NEVER TURN OFF MACHINE WHILE STILL PRODUCING COTTON CANDY (EXCEPT IN CASE OF EMERGENCY)
