Things That Can Be Recycled

- Aluminum Cans
- Card Stock
- Cardboard
- Clean Boxboard (Shoe Boxes, Cereal Boxes)
- Pizza Boxes (Without Leftovers Or Liners)
- Computer Paper
- Envelopes (Manila & Regular)
- File Folders
- Glass Bottles and Jars
- Junk Mail
- Magazines
- Newspapers (Please don't put them in plastic bags) If Papers are soiled or wet, try composting them
- Office paper (White &/or Colored)
- Plastic Bottles number 1-7
- Post It Notes
- Tin or Steel Cans

Not Acceptable Items

- Batteries
- Cell phones
- Ceramics
- Computers and other Electronics
- No Tangling Items (Holiday Lights, Ropes, Leashes, Garden Hose)
- Food Waste
- Glassware or Window Glass
- Plastic Bags (Return them to the grocery store)
- Printer Cartridge (Toner or Ink)
- Styrofoam
- Coat Hangers
- Shower Heads
- Plastic Wrap, Bubble Wrap, Sandwich bags, Or Freezer Bags
- Household Items (Shoes, Clothes, Kiddy Pools, Shower Liners
- Blister Or Clamshell Packaging
- Packing Peanuts
