Big Kahuna Slide

When using as a Slide with Water

When adding water to the Slide, follow the instructions for assembly and safety located on the Slide instruction sheet. Read and follow these additional assembly instructions for adding water to the slide.

1. Place the tarps provided around entrance and exit.
2. Grass can be damaged around the inflatable.
3. Do not set up near swimming pools.
4. You must use the GFI breaker provided at the source of electricity coming from the outlet or generator.
5. You may already have a GFI breaker on your outdoor electric outlet or generator. In that case, the portable GFI will not be used.
6. Use extra caution to see that the motor and electrical cords do not get wet.
7. Make sure all electrical cords are away from any foot traffic.
8. Attach the water hose to the top of the slide area and turn the water pressure to a LOW setting.
9. Note: Turning the water to a high setting will not make the slide work any better. It will cause a huge mess around the slide and can cause additional damage to the grass.
10. Make sure the pool is full of water before anyone slides down the slide.
11. Caution: Ensure that the slide is not left unattended at any time with water in or around the inflatable.
12. Turn the water off 30 minutes before deflating the unit to allow the unit to drain.
13. Clean all mud and debris off the slide before rolling it up.
14. The slide will be very heavy when it is wet. It will take 3-4 men to roll up the slide.
