## Duck Pond

### ATTENDANTS MUST READ HERE:

1. One adult attendant must supervise the game.
2. Never leave the Duck Pond unattended with ANY amount of water in the tub.
3. Always drain the tub when not in use or not attended.
4. If used inside, wipe up any splashes to prevent slipping or falling.
5. Never pull the pump by the electrical cord.
6. Be careful that no one trips over the electrical cord.
7. Do not use in severe weather or when lightning is visible.

### TO ASSEMBLE THE GAME:

1. Select a level area within 50' of a grounded 110 GFI electrical outlet and near a water source.
2. Put the tub on the base.
3. Put the two support posts in the side pocket of the framework.
4. Place the sign in the slots in the support posts
5. Attach the skirting to the Velcro.
6. Fill the tub with water. Do not leave it unattended with any water in the tub. A child could drown.
7. Place the pump under the water in the rear of the tub. After the pump is submerged, turn it on. It may be necessary to move the pump around so it will circulate the water and the ducks.
8. Unplug the pump before removing it from the water.

### TO PLAY THE GAME:

1. Allow the participants to select a duck from the water.
2. Fishing poles are provided as an alternative way to pick up the ducks.
3. The ducks are numbered 1, 2, and 3. There are a few LUCKY DUCKS. Award prizes.
