Ladder Golf

ATTENDANTS MUST READ HERE:

1. One adult attendant must supervise the game.
2. Do not allow participants to swing the balls unless tossing them at the ladder.
3. Do not pull excessively on the balls.
4. Do not stand or climb on the rungs of the ladders.
5. Create a safety zone to protect observers from being injured while contestants are tossing the balls

TO ASSEMBLE THE GAME:

1. Connect the base legs to the ladder using the knobs provided.
2. Place assembled ladder on level ground.
3. Secure the ladder with stakes or sandbags.
4. Create a Toss Line that should be about 15 feet from the ladder.

TO PLAY THE GAME:

1. Each player gets 3 balls. The object of the game is to wrap your balls around the ladder rungs.
2. Players toss the balls to the ladder to encircle one of the rungs.

SCORING:

1. Players encircle the rungs of the ladder to score EXACTLY 21 points.
2. Each player will toss all 3 balls before the next player is allowed to toss his balls.
3. The balls must be tossed underhanded and one at a time.
4. If a player goes over the exact 21 point total, that player's points for that round do not count.
5. If a ball is knocked off the target by another ball, it does not earn points.
6. Points are counted only after all balls have been tossed by all contestants.

Top rung score	3 points
Middle rung scores	2 points
Bottom rung scores	1 point

OPTIONAL BONUS POINTS:

If all 3 balls are on the same rung, contestant earns an additional point

If a ball lands on the same rung as an opposing player's ball, neither ball earns any points.

If all 3 balls are on different rungs, contestant earns an additional point.

If all balls are on all 3 (1-2-3) rungs contestant earns an additional point

In case of a tie, winner is determined by which player can earn 2 points more than the other in 1 round.

Scoring points for younger children can be simplified as needed to accommodate their age group.
